Dosage Form: Extended Release Tablet

Composition:

Each film-coated extended-release tablet contains:

- **Metoprolol Succinate IP 50 mg** (as extended-release formulation)

Description:

Metoperil XL 50 Tablet contains Metoprolol Succinate, a cardioselective beta-1 blocker used in cardiovascular management. It helps in **controlling high blood pressure, reducing cardiac workload, and stabilizing heart rate**, thereby supporting cardiovascular protection.

Indications:

Indicated for:

- Hypertension
- Angina pectoris
- Heart rate control in arrhythmias
- Long-term management after myocardial infarction
- Heart failure (as adjunct therapy)

It helps in improving overall cardiac function and reducing cardiovascular risk.

Dosage & Administration:

To be taken as directed by the physician.

Administer orally, preferably with or immediately after food.

Swallow whole; do not crush or chew the extended-release tablet.

Pharmacological Action:

Metoprolol Succinate selectively blocks beta-1 adrenergic receptors in the heart resulting in:

- Reduced heart rate and cardiac output
- Decreased myocardial oxygen demand
- Stabilization of cardiac conduction

Side Effects:

Fatigue, dizziness, mild bradycardia, or gastrointestinal discomfort may occur in some patients.

Precautions & Warnings:

- Use cautiously in patients with asthma, severe bradycardia, heart block, or peripheral vascular disorders
- Avoid abrupt discontinuation
- Monitor blood pressure and heart rate regularly

Drug Interactions:

May interact with calcium channel blockers, antiarrhythmics, antidiabetic drugs, or CNS depressants.

Storage:

Store below **25°C** in a cool, dry place.

Protect from moisture and light.

Keep out of reach of children.
