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Composition:

Each tablet contains:

- **Amlodipine IP** -5 mg
- **Atenolol IP** -50 mg
- **Excipients** -q.s.

Description:

Amlotyle AT Tablet is a **fixed-dose combination** of **Amlodipine**, a **calcium channel blocker** (**CCB**), and **Atenolol**, a **beta-blocker**. This combination works synergistically to effectively **control high blood pressure** (**hypertension**) and **manage heart-related conditions** by reducing heart rate, relaxing blood vessels, and improving blood flow.

Indications:

- Hypertension (High Blood Pressure)

Adverse Effects:

- Bradycardia (slow heart rate)
- Swelling in the feet or ankles (Amlodipine-related)
- Cold extremities (Atenolol-related)
- Shortness of breath in some patients

Storage:

- Store below 30°C in a cool, dry place, away from moisture and direct sunlight.
- Keep out of reach of **children**.
