# **Amlotyle H tablet**

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## **Composition:**

Each tablet contains:

- **Amlodipine IP** -5 mg
- **Hydrochlorothiazide IP** 12.5 mg
- **Excipients** -q.s.

#### **Description:**

Amlotyle H Tablet is a combination of **Amlodipine**, a **calcium channel blocker** (**CCB**), and **Hydrochlorothiazide** (**HCTZ**), a **thiazide diuretic**. This dual-action formulation helps in the effective management of **hypertension** (**high blood pressure**) by relaxing blood vessels and reducing fluid retention.

#### **Indications:**

- Hypertension (High Blood Pressure)
- Management of Edema associated with Hypertension
- Cardiovascular Risk Reduction

#### **Dosage & Administration:**

- Usual dose: One tablet once daily, or as prescribed by a healthcare professional.
- Can be taken with or without food, at the same time each day for best results.

#### **Contraindications:**

- Use with caution in diabetic patients as HCTZ can affect blood sugar levels.
- Monitor kidney function and electrolytes, especially potassium levels.
- Avoid excessive alcohol consumption as it may lower blood pressure further.

#### **Adverse Effects:**

- Dizziness, headache
- Swelling in the ankles or feet (Amlodipine-related)
- Frequent urination (due to HCTZ component)
- Electrolyte imbalance (low potassium or sodium levels)

## **Storage:**

- Store below 30°C in a cool, dry place, away from moisture and direct sunlight.
- Keep out of reach of **children**.
