Cefixime (100 mg) Tablet

Composition

Each tablet contains:

• Cefixime (as Cefixime Trihydrate): 100 mg

Description

Cefixime 100 mg Tablet is an oral thirdgeneration cephalosporin antibiotic that effectively treats a range of bacterial infections. It works by inhibiting bacterial cell wall synthesis, leading to bacterial cell death. Cefixime is commonly used for infections where broad-spectrum coverage is required.

Indications

Cefixime 100 mg Tablet is indicated for the treatment of bacterial infections, including:

- Upper respiratory tract infections: Tonsillitis, pharyngitis, and sinusitis
- Lower respiratory tract infections: Bronchitis and mild pneumonia
- Urinary tract infections: Cystitis and pyelonephritis
- Otitis media (middle ear infections)
- Typhoid fever
- Uncomplicated gonorrhea

Dosage and Administration

- Adults and Adolescents (≥12 years):
 - The typical dose is 200–400 mg daily, either as a single dose or divided into two doses every 12 hours.
- Children (under 12 years):
 - Dosage is typically based on body weight and given as 8 mg/kg/day, either as a single dose or divided into two doses.
- Administration:
 - Tablets should be taken orally with or without food.
 - Taking with food may improve absorption and reduce gastrointestinal discomfort.

Mechanism of Action

Cefixime binds to penicillin-binding proteins (PBPs) in the bacterial cell wall, inhibiting the final stage of bacterial cell wall synthesis. This leads to cell wall weakening and ultimately bacterial death.

Contraindications

- Known hypersensitivity to cefixime, other cephalosporins, or any excipients in the formulation.
- Severe allergic reactions to penicillin or other beta-lactam antibiotics.

Warnings and Precautions

- Allergic Reactions: Discontinue immediately if signs of hypersensitivity appear, such as rash, swelling, or difficulty breathing.
- Renal Impairment: Use with caution in patients with renal impairment; dose adjustment may be necessary.
- Superinfection: Prolonged use can lead to the overgrowth of resistant organisms, including fungi.
- Clostridium difficile-associated Diarrhea (CDAD): Monitor for signs of severe diarrhea; discontinue if symptoms are severe.

Side Effects

Common side effects include:

- Gastrointestinal: Diarrhea, nausea, abdominal pain
- Allergic reactions: Skin rash, itching, urticaria
- Less common: Headache, dizziness, elevated liver enzymes

Drug Interactions

- Anticoagulants: Cefixime may increase the risk of bleeding; monitor INR/PT with anticoagulants like warfarin.
- Probenecid: Can increase serum levels of cefixime.
- Live bacterial vaccines: Cefixime may reduce the efficacy of live bacterial vaccines, such as the typhoid vaccine.

Storage

- Store at room temperature (below 25°C) in a dry place, protected from light and moisture.
- · Keep out of reach of children.
