- Generic Name: Diclofenac Sodium

- **Preparation**: Ensure aseptic technique during administration. For IV use, dilute as directed.

Contraindications

- Hypersensitivity to Diclofenac or other NSAIDs
- History of asthma, urticaria, or allergic reactions after NSAID use
- Active peptic ulcer, gastrointestinal bleeding, or perforation
- Severe hepatic, renal, or cardiac impairment

Warnings and Precautions

- Use with caution in patients with cardiovascular disease, hypertension, or fluid retention.
- Monitor renal and hepatic function during prolonged use.
- Avoid in the third trimester of pregnancy (risk of premature closure of the ductus arteriosus).
- Not recommended during breastfeeding unless clearly necessary.

Adverse Effects

• Common: Nausea, vomiting, headache, dizziness, injection site reactions

• Rare but serious: Gastrointestinal bleeding, hepatotoxicity, nephrotoxicity, anaphylactic reactions
