#### What is Fexofenadine?

Fexofenadine is an antihistamine used to relieve allergy symptoms such as:

- Seasonal allergic rhinitis (hay fever) symptoms like sneezing, runny nose, itchy or watery eyes.
- Chronic idiopathic urticaria (hives) with symptoms such as itching and skin rashes.

It works by blocking histamine, a substance produced by the body during an allergic reaction.

#### **Dosage and Administration**

- **Standard Dose:** 180 mg once daily, preferably taken with water.
- Administration:
  - Take on an empty stomach for better absorption.
  - Avoid taking with fruit juices (e.g., orange or grapefruit juice) as they may decrease the drug's effectiveness.
  - Do not crush or chew the tablet.

## Precautions

- Consult Your Doctor:
  - If you have kidney problems or are on other medications.
  - If you are pregnant, planning to become pregnant, or breastfeeding.
- Avoid alcohol or sedatives, as they may enhance drowsiness.

## **Potential Side Effects**

#### Common:

- Headache
- Drowsiness (less common compared to firstgeneration antihistamines)
- Nausea

#### **Rare but Serious:**

• Allergic reactions like swelling, rash, or difficulty breathing.

## **Drug Interactions**

- Avoid combining with antacids containing aluminum or magnesium within 2 hours of taking fexofenadine.
- May interact with ketoconazole or erythromycin.

**Storage:** Keep in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and out of reach of children.
