Antibiotic Segment (Cephalosporin Group)

Description:

Fixolexin ER 750 Tablet contains **Cephalexin**, a first-generation cephalosporin antibiotic. It works by inhibiting bacterial cell wall synthesis, thereby killing the bacteria and treating infections effectively. The extended-release formulation provides sustained drug release, ensuring prolonged antibacterial action and convenient once- or twice-daily dosing.

Uses / Indications:

Fixolexin ER 750 Tablet is indicated for the treatment of bacterial infections such as:

- Respiratory tract infections (bronchitis, pharyngitis, tonsillitis)
- Urinary tract infections
- Skin and soft tissue infections
- Bone and joint infections
- Otitis media and sinus infections

It helps in: managing bacterial infections caused by susceptible microorganisms, ensuring faster recovery and reduced recurrence risk.

Dosage & Administration:

As directed by the physician.

Typically taken once or twice daily after meals with water.

Do not crush or chew the tablet; swallow it whole to maintain the extended-release effect.

Contraindications:

- Known hypersensitivity to cephalosporins or penicillins
- Severe renal impairment (dose adjustment may be required)

Warnings & Precautions:

- Use with caution in patients with a history of allergic reactions to beta-lactam antibiotics.
- Prolonged use may result in secondary infections or antibiotic resistance.
- Renal function monitoring is advised in elderly or renally impaired patients.

Side Effects:

- Nausea, diarrhea, abdominal pain
- Skin rash or allergic reactions (rare)
- Headache or dizziness (occasional)

Storage:

Store in a cool, dry place below 25°C.

Protect from moisture and direct sunlight.

Keep out of reach of children.

Packaging:

Available in strip packs of 10 extended-release tablets.
