## Flupirtine 100mg Capsule Information

**Generic Name: Flupirtine**

Therapeutic Class: Non-Opioid Analgesic

## **Description**

Flupirtine is a centrally acting non-opioid analgesic with muscle-relaxant properties. It works by acting as a selective neuronal potassium channel opener (SNEPCO) and NMDA receptor antagonist, providing pain relief and muscle relaxation. Unlike opioids, it does not induce dependency or respiratory depression.

#### **Indications**

Flupirtine 100mg capsules are indicated for the management of:

- Acute and chronic pain of various origins, such as:
  - Musculoskeletal pain (e.g., back pain, neck pain).
  - o Post-surgical pain.
  - Dysmenorrhea (menstrual pain).
  - Headaches not related to migraines.
- Pain associated with tension and muscle spasms.

## **Dosage and Administration**

- Adults: 100mg 2-3 times daily. In severe cases, the dose may be increased to 400mg daily, divided into multiple doses.
- Maximum Dose: Should not exceed 600mg/day.
- Elderly or Patients with Hepatic Impairment: Dosage adjustments may be required; consult a healthcare professional.

#### **Duration of Use:**

• Use for the shortest duration necessary to control pain, generally not exceeding 2 weeks without reassessment.

#### **Contraindications**

- Hypersensitivity to flupirtine or any excipients in the formulation.
- Severe hepatic impairment or active liver disease.
- History of chronic alcohol abuse.
- Use in patients with cholestasis or myasthenia gravis.

#### **Precautions**

 Hepatic Monitoring: Regular liver function tests are recommended during prolonged use. Discontinue if significant liver enzyme elevation occurs.

- CNS Effects: May cause dizziness or drowsiness; avoid activities requiring mental alertness until the effect is known.
- Dependency: Long-term use is not recommended to avoid potential abuse or dependency.
- Pregnancy and Lactation: Use only if clearly needed and prescribed by a healthcare provider.

### **Side Effects**

#### **Common side effects:**

- Dizziness
- Drowsiness
- Nausea
- Fatigue

#### Rare but serious side effects:

- Hepatotoxicity (jaundice, elevated liver enzymes)
- Allergic reactions (rash, itching, swelling)

## **Drug Interactions**

- May enhance the sedative effects of alcohol and CNS depressants.
- Concomitant use with hepatotoxic drugs (e.g., paracetamol, certain antibiotics) may increase the risk of liver damage.

## **Storage Instructions**

- Store at room temperature (15-25°C).
- Protect from light and moisture.

Keep out of reach of children.

#### **Additional Notes**

- Flupirtine is intended for short-term use and should be taken under medical supervision.
- Seek immediate medical attention if signs of liver dysfunction (e.g., dark urine, yellowing of the skin or eyes) occur.
