### **Composition:**

Each capsule contains:

- Glycopyrronium 25 mcg
- Formoterol 12 mcg
- Budesonide 400 mcg

## **Description:**

Glycopryl FB is a **triple-combination inhalation therapy** designed for the **management of chronic respiratory diseases** such as **COPD (Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease) and Asthma**. It contains:

- **Glycopyrronium** (a long-acting muscarinic antagonist LAMA) that helps in **bronchodilation**.
- **Formoterol** (a long-acting beta-agonist LABA) that works to **relax airway muscles** for easier breathing.
- **Budesonide** (a corticosteroid) that **reduces inflammation** and prevents asthma and COPD flare-ups.

#### **Indications:**

- Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD)
- Moderate to severe Asthma
- Chronic bronchitis and emphysema management

### **Dosage & Administration:**

#### **Warnings & Precautions:**

- Not a rescue medication for sudden breathing problems.
- May cause **oral thrush**, so rinse mouth after use.
- Use with caution in patients with cardiovascular disorders.
- Consult a doctor if pregnant or breastfeeding.

# **Side Effects:**

- Mild throat irritation or cough
- Headache or dizziness
- Increased heart rate (tachycardia) (rare)
- Dry mouth or hoarseness

# **Storage Instructions:**

- Store in a cool, dry place away from moisture.
- Keep out of reach of children.
