Each ml contains:

- Levosulpiride 12.5 mg
- Water for Injection q.s.

Description:

Levosulpiride is a substituted benzamide derivative with prokinetic and antipsychotic properties. It acts as a selective antagonist of dopamine D2 receptors, enhancing gastrointestinal motility and controlling symptoms related to functional dyspepsia, GERD, and certain psychiatric conditions.

Indications:

- Functional dyspepsia
- Gastroesophageal reflux disease (GERD)
- Irritable bowel syndrome
- Chronic gastritis
- Negative symptoms of schizophrenia
- Depression with somatic symptoms

Dosage and Administration:

- As directed by the physician
- Administered via intramuscular or slow intravenous injection

- Store in a cool, dry place below 25°C
- Protect from light and freezing
- Keep out of reach of children
