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Dosage Form: Topical Dusting Powder

Therapeutic Category: Antifungal (Topical Use)

Composition:

Each gram contains:

- Luliconazole I.P. 1% w/w
- Excipients: q.s.

Description:

Lunityle Dusting Powder contains Luliconazole 1% w/w, a broad-spectrum imidazole antifungal agent. It works by inhibiting ergosterol synthesis, an essential component of fungal cell membranes, leading to disruption of fungal growth. The powder form enhances skin dryness and prevents maceration in intertriginous areas, making it suitable for high-humidity environments and areas prone to sweating.

Indications:

- Tinea corporis (ringworm of the body)
- Tinea cruris (jock itch)
- Tinea pedis (athlete's foot)
- Candidal intertrigo
- Pityriasis versicolor
- Fungal infections in sweat-prone and occluded areas

Usage Instructions:

- Clean and dry the affected area thoroughly.
- Apply a thin layer of the dusting powder to the affected area once or twice daily or as directed by a physician.
- Avoid contact with eyes, mouth, and mucous membranes.
- Continue use for the prescribed duration, even if symptoms improve earlier, to prevent recurrence.

Contraindications:

- Hypersensitivity to Luliconazole or any component of the formulation

Warnings and Precautions:

- For external use only
- Do not use on broken or irritated skin without medical advice
- Discontinue use if signs of irritation or hypersensitivity occur

Adverse Effects:

- Mild local irritation, burning, or redness
- Allergic reactions (rare)

Storage:

- Store in a cool and dry place below 25°C
- Keep the container tightly closed
- Protect from moisture and direct sunlight
- Keep out of reach of children

- Dusting powder bottle containing Luliconazole I.P. 1% w/w
- Available in 75g / 100g HDPE containers (customizable)
