## Megestrol Acetate 160 mg SR Tablet

## Generic Name:

Megestrol Acetate

## **Strength:**

160 mg

## **Formulation:**

Sustained Release (SR) tablet

## **Uses:**

Megestrol Acetate 160 mg SR is primarily used in the treatment of the following conditions:

### 1. Anorexia and Cachexia:

- Used to stimulate appetite and promote weight gain in patients suffering from conditions such as cancer or AIDS, where weight loss and loss of appetite are common.
- It helps to improve nutritional intake and body mass in patients with severe unintentional weight loss.

## 2. Breast Cancer (Adjuvant Therapy):

 Megestrol acetate is sometimes used in the treatment of breast cancer, especially in postmenopausal women with hormone receptor-positive tumors. It works by lowering estrogen levels, which can help slow or stop the growth of hormonedependent cancer cells.

### 3. Endometrial Cancer:

 It is also used to treat endometrial cancer, where it can help inhibit the growth of cancer cells by modifying hormone levels.

## **Mechanism of Action:**

Megestrol acetate is a **synthetic progestin** (a type of synthetic hormone) that mimics the action of **progesterone**, a natural hormone in the body. Its actions include:

- Appetite Stimulation: It increases appetite and food intake by influencing the hypothalamus (the brain region that regulates hunger).
- Anti-estrogenic Effect: In cancers like breast and endometrial cancer, megestrol acetate works by blocking the action of estrogen on tumor cells, slowing their growth.
- Inhibition of Tumor Growth: Reduces the growth of hormone-sensitive tumors by altering hormonal levels in the body.

## **Dosage:**

- Typical Dose for Anorexia and Cachexia:
  - 160 mg SR tablet, taken once daily, preferably at the same time each day.
  - Duration of use depends on the patient's condition and response to treatment.
- Typical Dose for Cancer Treatment:
  - Dose may vary depending on the specific cancer type and stage. The dosage should be determined by a healthcare provider.
- Administration:
  - This is a sustained-release tablet and should not be crushed or chewed. It should be taken whole with a glass of water.
  - o **Food:** It can be taken with or without food.

## **Precautions:**

- Pregnancy and Breastfeeding:
  - Megestrol acetate should **not** be used during **pregnancy** due to potential risks to the developing fetus. It is also **not recommended** for breastfeeding mothers.
- Liver Disease:

 Use with caution in individuals with liver disease. Close monitoring may be required.

## • Blood Clotting Disorders:

 Megestrol acetate can increase the risk of blood clots. Patients with a history of blood clots or stroke should discuss this with their healthcare provider before use.

#### Diabetes:

 Megestrol acetate may affect blood sugar levels, so people with diabetes should monitor their blood sugar closely during treatment.

## **Side Effects:**

## • Common:

- Weight gain
- Increased appetite
- o Fluid retention
- Swelling in the legs or feet
- Hot flashes or night sweats

### • Less Common:

- Nausea or vomiting
- o Abdominal discomfort
- Fatigue
- Mood changes or depression

## • Serious (Seek Medical Attention):

- Severe allergic reactions (rash, itching, swelling of the face or throat, difficulty breathing)
- Symptoms of **blood clots** (pain, redness, or swelling in the legs, sudden chest pain, or difficulty breathing)
- Severe abdominal pain or jaundice (yellowing of the skin or eyes)

## **Drug Interactions:**

Megestrol acetate may interact with other medications, including:

### Anticoagulants (e.g., warfarin):

 May increase the risk of bleeding. Regular monitoring of blood clotting parameters is advised.

## Diabetes Medications:

 Megestrol acetate may interfere with blood sugar control, so close monitoring is needed for diabetic patients.

### Hormonal Medications:

 Use with caution if you are taking other hormonal treatments (e.g., birth control, hormone replacement therapy).

Always inform your healthcare provider about all medications, supplements, and herbal products you are taking.

## **Storage:**

- Store at 20°C to 25°C (68°F to 77°F).
- Keep the tablets in a dry place, away from light and moisture.
- Keep out of reach of children.

## Note:

Megestrol acetate is **not a cure** for cancer, but rather part of a **treatment regimen** aimed at managing symptoms and improving quality of life.

- It is important to follow your healthcare provider's instructions carefully and attend regular follow-up appointments to monitor progress.
- Do not stop or adjust the dosage without consulting your doctor.
