Drug Class:

- Bromfenac: Non-Steroidal Anti-Inflammatory Drug (NSAID)
- Moxifloxacin: Fluoroquinolone Antibiotic

Description:

This combination eye drop contains Bromfenac, an anti-inflammatory agent that reduces pain and swelling, and Moxifloxacin, an antibiotic that treats bacterial infections. Together, they are used to manage post-operative eye inflammation and prevent or treat bacterial infections in the eyes.

Indications:

Storage:

- Store in a cool, dry place, below 25°C.
- Protect from light and moisture.
- Keep out of reach of children.
- Do not use after the expiry date or if the solution changes color.
