Moxifloxacin (0.5% w/v) + Prednisolone (1% w/v)

Moxolunic PD Ear Drop

Moxifloxacin (0.5% w/v) + Prednisolone (1% w/v) Ear Drops

Composition

- Moxifloxacin: 0.5% w/v
- Prednisolone: 1% w/v

Description

This combination ear drop formulation contains:

1. Moxifloxacin: A broad-spectrum fluoroquinolone antibiotic that inhibits bacterial DNA gyrase and topoisomerase IV, effectively targeting a wide range of Gram-positive and Gram-negative bacteria, and preventing bacterial replication.
2. Prednisolone: A corticosteroid with potent anti-inflammatory effects, reducing inflammation, pain, and swelling associated with ear infections.

Indications

- Acute otitis externa (infection of the external ear canal)
- Chronic otitis media (with or without associated bacterial infection)

Dosage and Administration

- Instill 2-3 drops into the affected ear(s) 2-3 times daily or as directed by a healthcare professional.
- Tilt the head or lie down with the affected ear facing upward for a few minutes to allow for proper absorption.

Contraindications

- Prednisolone, or any other component of the formulation.
- Fungal or viral infections of the ear.
- Perforation of the tympanic membrane (eardrum) unless under medical supervision.

Precautions

- Use with caution in patients with a history of allergic reactions to fluoroquinolones or corticosteroids.
- Prolonged use may result in overgrowth of non-susceptible organisms, including fungi.
- Avoid use if the eardrum is perforated, unless directed by a healthcare professional.

Adverse Effects

- Local irritation, stinging, or burning sensation in the ear.
- Rare allergic reactions such as rash, itching, or swelling.
- Potential for increased intraocular pressure or cataracts with prolonged use of corticosteroids.

Storage

- Store below 25°C in a cool, dry place, protected from light.
- Keep the bottle tightly closed and out of reach of children.

Presentation

Available in sterile dropper bottles of 5 mL or 10 mL.
