Dosage Form: Tablet

Composition:

Each film-coated tablet contains:

- Hydroxychloroquine Sulfate IP equivalent to Hydroxychloroquine 300 mg
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Description:

Quinhub 300 Tablet contains Hydroxychloroquine, an antimalarial and immunomodulatory agent. It is indicated for the management of autoimmune and inflammatory conditions as well as malaria. It helps in reducing inflammation, modulating immune response, and controlling disease progression in chronic conditions.

Indications:

Indicated for the treatment of:

- Rheumatoid arthritis
- Systemic lupus erythematosus (SLE)
- Malaria (treatment and prophylaxis)

It helps in reducing joint inflammation, controlling autoimmune activity, and preventing malarial infection.

Dosage & Administration:

Dosage should be as directed by the physician.

The tablet should be taken with food or milk to minimize gastrointestinal discomfort.

Long-term therapy requires regular medical supervision and monitoring.

Pharmacological Action:

- **Hydroxychloroquine** interferes with lysosomal activity and antigen presentation, thereby reducing immune activation.
- It also inhibits inflammatory mediators and modulates cytokine production.
- In malaria, it acts by interfering with parasite growth within red blood cells.

These mechanisms help in controlling inflammation and suppressing disease activity.

Side Effects:

Common side effects include nausea, abdominal pain, headache, and skin rash.

Long-term use may rarely cause retinal toxicity, visual disturbances, or cardiomyopathy.

Periodic ophthalmic evaluation is recommended.

Precautions & Warnings:

- Use with caution in patients with hepatic or renal impairment
 - Regular eye examinations are recommended during prolonged therapy
 - Monitor for signs of cardiotoxicity and muscle weakness
 - Not recommended in patients with known hypersensitivity to 4-aminoquinoline compounds
 - Use during pregnancy only if clearly advised by the physician
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Drug Interactions:

May interact with digoxin, antidiabetic drugs, and medications prolonging QT interval.

Concomitant use with other antimalarials or immunosuppressants requires caution.

Storage:

Store below 25°C in a cool, dry place.

Protect from light and moisture.

Keep out of reach of children.
