Composition:

Each 5 ml contains:

- **Ranitidine Hydrochloride IP 75 mg**

Description:

Ranityle Suspension is an H₂-receptor antagonist used for the treatment of acid-related gastrointestinal disorders. It helps in reducing gastric acid secretion, providing relief from heartburn, acid reflux, and related symptoms.

Indications:

Indicated for:

- Gastric and duodenal ulcers
- Gastroesophageal reflux disease (GERD)
- Zollinger-Ellison syndrome

It helps in controlling excess stomach acid and promoting healing of ulcers.

Dosage & Administration:

Dosage should be as directed by the physician.

Administer orally, preferably before meals.

Shake well before use and measure accurately using a calibrated measuring device.

Pharmacological Action:

- **Ranitidine:** Competitively inhibits H₂ receptors on gastric parietal cells, reducing secretion of gastric acid and promoting ulcer healing

Side Effects:

Mild headache, dizziness, or gastrointestinal discomfort may occur in some patients.

Precautions & Warnings:

- Use with caution in patients with renal or hepatic impairment
- Not recommended during pregnancy or lactation unless advised by the physician
- Monitor for signs of hypersensitivity

Drug Interactions:

May interact with antacids, warfarin, or other drugs metabolized via the liver; consult physician before co-administration.

Storage:

Store below 25°C in a cool, dry place.

Protect from light and moisture.
