Composition:

Each uncoated tablet contains:

- Telmisartan I.P. 40 mg
- Amlodipine Besylate I.P. 5 mg
- Chlorthalidone I.P. 6.25 mg

Description:

Telbolife ACH 6.25 Tablet is a fixed-dose combination of **Telmisartan**, **Amlodipine**, and **Chlorthalidone**, formulated to manage **hypertension** effectively.

- **Telmisartan**: An **angiotensin II receptor blocker** (**ARB**) that helps relax blood vessels and reduce blood pressure.
