Terbinafine (250 mg) Tablet

Effective Treatment for Fungal Infections

Description

Terbinafine 250 mg tablet is an **antifungal medication** that works by **inhibiting the growth of fungi** responsible for a variety of infections. - **Pregnancy & Breastfeeding:**
 - Use only if prescribed by a healthcare provider. It is generally not recommended during pregnancy or breastfeeding unless necessary.
- **Allergies:**
 - Inform your doctor if you are allergic to Terbinafine or any of its ingredients.
- **Drug Interactions:**
 - Inform your doctor about any other medications you are taking, especially those affecting liver function (e.g., warfarin, cyclosporine).

Storage

- Store at room temperature between **15°C to 30°C.**
- Keep away from moisture, heat, and direct sunlight.
- Keep out of reach of children.
