Terbinafine (500 mg) Tablet Effective Treatment for Severe Fungal Infections

Description

Terbinafine 500 mg tablet is a broad-spectrum antifungal medication used to treat various severe fungal infections. This medication is particularly effective for treating onychomycosis (fungal nail infections) and dermatophyte infections that do not respond to other treatments. Indications

- Onychomycosis (Fungal Nail Infection):
 - Terbinafine 500 mg is primarily used to treat fungal nail infections that affect the toenails and fingernails, caused by dermatophytes like **Trichophyton** species.
- Severe Dermatophyte Infections:
 - Including athlete's foot (tinea pedis), ringworm (tinea corporis), and jock itch (tinea cruris).
- Other Fungal Infections:

- For treatment of systemic or extensive fungal infections when topical treatments are insufficient.
- Fungal Infections of the Skin & Scalp:
 - Also used in treating tinea capitis (scalp ringworm).

Dosage and Administration

- Adults:
 - The typical dose for onychomycosis is 1 tablet (500 mg) once daily for 6 to 12 weeks.
 - For severe dermatophyte infections, the usual dose is 500 mg once daily for 4 to 6 weeks, depending on the infection type and severity.
- Children:
 - Generally not recommended for children unless prescribed by a doctor.
- Administration:
 - Take the tablet whole with or without food.
 - Do not crush or chew the tablet.

- Taste disturbances: Loss of taste is possible, which may affect appetite.

If you experience any of these serious side effects, seek medical attention immediately.

Precautions

Liver Health:

 Monitor liver function before and during treatment. Terbinafine can affect liver enzymes, and liver function should be checked periodically.

• Kidney Function:

 Use with caution in patients with kidney problems.

Pregnancy and Breastfeeding:

 Terbinafine should be avoided during pregnancy, unless absolutely necessary, and is not recommended for breastfeeding mothers. Consult a healthcare provider before use.

• Allergic Reactions:

Discontinue use if any signs of an allergic reaction occur.

Drug Interactions:

 Terbinafine may interact with other medications, such as those for high blood pressure, antifungal drugs, and cytochrome P450 enzyme inhibitors.
 Inform your doctor about all other medications you are taking.

Storage

- Store in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight.
- Keep the medication out of reach of children.

Use Terbinafine under the supervision of a healthcare provider. For fungal infections that do not improve or worsen during treatment, seek further medical advice.
