Terbinafine (1% w/w) Cream

Terbixyle Cream

Brand Name: Terbixyle Cream

Dosage Form: Topical Cream

Therapeutic Category: Antifungal

Composition:

Each 15 gm contains:

- Terbinafine Hydrochloride IP 1% w/w
- Excipients – q.s.

Pharmacology & Mechanism of Action:

Terbinafine is an allylamine antifungal that inhibits squalene epoxidase, an enzyme critical for ergosterol synthesis in fungal cell membranes. This leads to accumulation of squalene and disruption of cell membrane integrity, causing fungal cell death. Terbinafine is effective against dermatophytes, yeasts, and other pathogenic fungi.

Indications:

- Dermatophytosis (tinea corporis, tinea cruris, tinea pedis)
- Candidal skin infections
- Pityriasis versicolor

Dosage & Administration:

- Apply a thin layer of cream to the affected area and surrounding skin once or twice daily as directed by a physician
- Duration of treatment depends on infection type; continue for the full prescribed course even if symptoms improve

Contraindications:

- Hypersensitivity to Terbinafine or any component of the formulation

Warnings & Precautions:

- Avoid contact with eyes, mouth, and mucous membranes
- Discontinue if severe irritation or hypersensitivity occurs
- Not recommended for use on large areas of broken or eczematous skin without medical supervision

Adverse Effects:

- Common: Mild burning, itching, redness, or irritation at application site
- Rare: Allergic reactions, blistering, or rash

Storage:

Store below 25°C in a cool, dry place

Protect from light

Keep out of reach of children
