## **Description:**

Methylprednisolone (40 mg) Injection is a corticosteroid used to manage severe inflammatory, allergic, and autoimmune conditions. It provides rapid relief in acute episodes by suppressing inflammation and modulating immune response.

**Composition:** 

Each vial contains:

 Methylprednisolone Sodium Succinate equivalent to Methylprednisolone 40 mg

Indications:

Methylprednisolone (40 mg) injection is indicated for:

- 1. Severe Allergic Reactions:
  - Anaphylaxis or drug hypersensitivity.
- 2. Rheumatic Disorders:
  - Rheumatoid arthritis, gouty arthritis, or ankylosing spondylitis.
- 3. Respiratory Conditions:
  - Acute exacerbations of asthma or chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD).
- 4. Skin Conditions:

- Store the vial at 15°C–25°C (room temperature).
- Protect from light and moisture.
- Use reconstituted solution immediately; discard unused portions.
