## Cefoperazone:

- Can be recommended for the clinical practice against gram bacteria exhibiting resistance to other antimicrobials & is a cheaper alter-native to meropenem.
- It is one of few cephalosporin antibiotics effective in treating pseudomonas bacterial infections which are otherwise resistant to these antibiotics.

## Tazobactam:

- Is a beta lactamase inhibitor and prevents the interaction of the enzyme with the antibiotic molecule.
- In such a way it extends the spectrum of cefoperazone
  Sulbactam:
- Enhances the activity of Ceftriaxone against many resistant strains of bacteria
