Formoterol

- » Formoterol is a long-acting bronchodilator used to treat asthma and COPD by relaxing airway muscles.
- » It activates beta-2 receptors in the lungs, leading to airway dilation and improved breathing..
- » Used for long-term asthma management, COPD symptom relief, and often combined with inhaled steroids
- » Possible side effects include headaches, tremors, increased heart rate, and muscle cramps..

Fluticasone Propionate

- » Fluticasone Propionate is a corticosteroid used to treat asthma, COPD, and allergic rhinitis by reducing inflammation in the airways.
- » It reduces inflammation by binding to glucocorticoid receptors, preventing the release of inflammatory substances.
- » Commonly used for preventing asthma attacks, managing COPD symptoms, and treating allergic rhinitis.
- » Potential side effects include sore throat, headache, nasal irritation, and, with long-term use, risks like bone loss or adrenal suppression.
